

Playtime Scheduler is used to post pickleball schedules and locations. The website is www.playtimescheduler.com. Playtime Scheduler works well on smartphones, tablets, laptops and desktop computers. Best of all, it's FREE for a basic version. If you want to play pickleball in Lincoln, you need to have a Playtime Scheduler account.

Players must register and create a Playtime Scheduler account. Players can then log into Playtime Scheduler and will see a series of round "Pickleballs". Clicking on a ball will bring up a description of the session, specific location, scheduled time, and a list of players who have signed up. It's easy for players to sign up to play or come back and remove their names. Some sessions may focus on beginner or recreational skill level, intermediate skill level, or advanced skill level. Clicking on a map icon on the lower left of the main screen will show all current pickleball play locations in the greater Lincoln area. Over 2,400 registered users rely on Playtime Scheduler to see schedules and communicate their plans to play.

Types of Pickleball Play (all locations)

Open Play--loosely organized by the players themselves. Players arrive and leave the court venue as they wish. When four players are done with a game, those waiting should be invited to rotate onto the court. Being respectful, friendly, and allowing all to participate is the key to making this type of play work. All players of all skill levels are welcome.

Round Robin (RR) Play—structured play run by a coordinator who organizes and runs the pickleball session. A session typically lasts about two hours and games are typically timed (12-13 minutes). After each game, players switch courts, partners and opponents based on how the

coordinator has chosen to organize the session. Round Robins may specify required skill levels for participants.

Tournaments, Lessons and Clinics—several organizations offer opportunites to participate in competitive play through tournaments or further skill development through lessons and clinics. These opportunities are promoted through organizations' websites or social media.
